Grammar rules you will learn.

- 'Une' is used in front of feminine nouns; 'un' is used in front of masculine nouns.
- In French, some items of clothing are masculine, some are feminine. If an adjective is used to describe the item of clothing (noun) then it must agree. Eg un pull vert- une jupe verte ('e' added because 'jupe' is feminine).
- 'Des' is used for plural items.
- Trousers is not seen as plural in French!
- Word order- the adjective follows the noun.

What you should know...
