

The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane by Kate DiCamillo

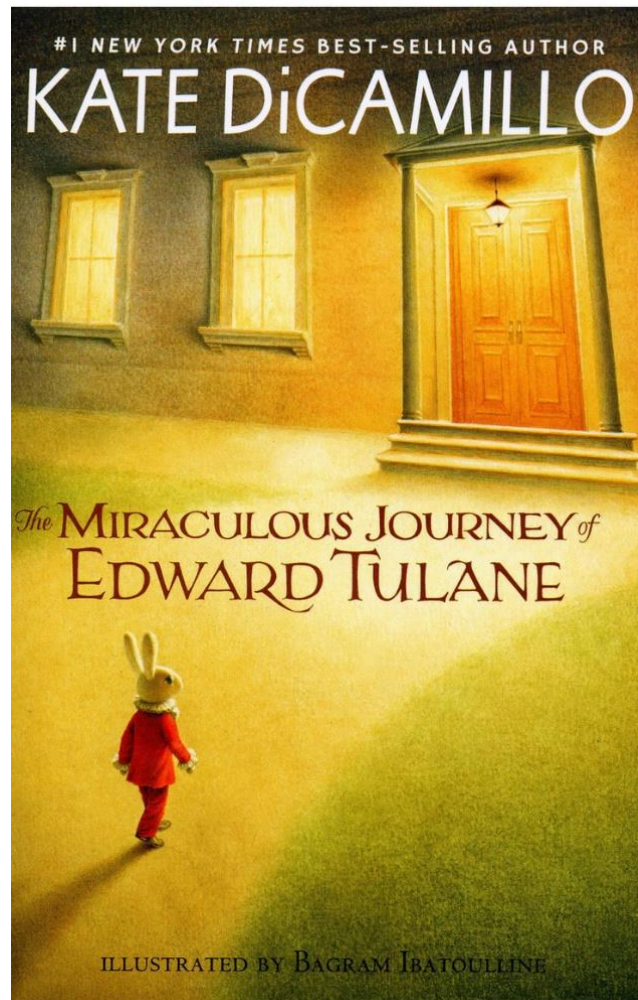
is a wonderfully beautiful book about a rabbit that has to endure the most amazing of journeys to find true love in the world.
