CONTACT AND READING

All pupils have been given a homework diary. This is designed to promote their independence as the diary has space for important events happening throughout the year.

The homework diary should also be used to record any reading your child has completed each week. We expect your child to read at home a minimum of four times throughout the week. Please sign to show you have listened to them read. **This is really important.** The homework diary should be brought into school daily and handed in to be checked each Monday morning. We will note down their reading and provided they have the minimum amount of signatures from a parent or guardian, they can earn house points and stickers.

Spellings and homework will be given out every Thursday and expected in the following Wednesday. The children will also be given a spelling test every Wednesday.

Please feel free to write comments in your child's homework diary should you like to. If you would like to make us aware of anything non-urgent, then feel free to add a note in the diary. However, it is your child's responsibility to hand it to us should you have written a note in (as we will only ask to see homework diaries on Monday mornings).
