

# Alphabet and Revised Greetings

## Phrases you will learn.

Bonjour!- Hello (formal)

Salut- Hi (informal)

Ça va? How are you?

Ça va bien- I am well

ça va mal- I am not well

Comme çi, comme ça –so so

Et vous?- and you? (formal)

Et toi?- and you? (informal)

Au revoir- goodbye



## What you should know...

In France, Greetings are used when you meet up with someone. This maybe someone you know (like your friends) in which case you will use **informal** phrases. If you greet someone who is not familiar to you, you will use **formal** phrases as this is more polite.

In French, written accents help us to understand how letters are pronounced. The accent under the c 'ç' helps us to understand that this is pronounced like a 's' in English.
