

What matters most to Christians and Humanists?

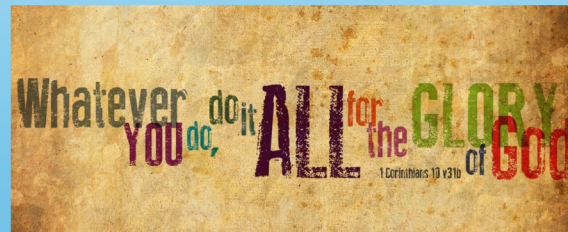
You will already:

Key Vocab:

Humanist- Humanists do not believe in a god. They believe it is possible to live a good and fulfilling life without following a traditional religion.

Christian- A Christian is someone who believes in Jesus Christ and follows his teachings.

Moral- the principles of right and wrong behaviour
